Maintenance Tech II

Maintenance Technician II performs skilled and semi-skilled maintenance work related to the operation, repair, cleanliness, and safety of parks, recreational facilities, athletic fields, buildings, pool, grounds, and district equipment. This position supports daily district operations and assists in preparing facilities for recreational programs, sports leagues, and community events. Work may require evenings, weekends, holidays, and emergency response as needed.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Perform routine maintenance and repair of park facilities, playgrounds, restrooms, athletic fields, community pool, buildings, and grounds.
- Maintain sports fields including mowing, edging, lining, dragging, irrigation monitoring, and turf repair.
- Inspect district properties for safety hazards and maintenance needs.
- Operates, light, and heavy maintenance equipment including mowers, tractors, utility vehicles, aerators, sprayers, weed trimmers, blowers, tractors, power equipment, and hand tools.
- Performs routine maintenance on tools, equipment, and facilities.
- Works and operates equipment following safety procedures and uses safety equipment.
- Performs operations of motor vehicles and/or power equipment with intermittent vibration.
- Assist with irrigation troubleshooting, valve repair, sprinkler replacement, and timer adjustments.
- Assist with landscaping, tree work, and turf renovation.
- Operate specialized equipment related to construction and improvement work.
- Coordinate project tasks with supervisory staff.
- Perform minor plumbing, carpentry, painting, electrical, fencing, and concrete repairs.
- Clean restrooms, picnic shelters, sidewalks, and public-use areas.
- Remove trash, weeds, graffiti, and debris from district properties.
- Set up and break down tables, chairs, barricades, sports equipment, and event materials for programs and special events.
- Assist with community events, tournaments, and district-sponsored activities, including weekend support.
- Respond to urgent maintenance issues and facility emergencies.
- Maintain tools, supplies, and maintenance records.
- Follow district safety procedures and safe work practices, ensure work is completed safely and according to District standards.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Compiles with Wasco Recreation and Park District Occupational Injury & Illness Prevention Program. Reports safety and sanitary hazards to the District Manager.

Follows oral and written instructions.

Works harmoniously and cooperatively with fellow employees and the public.

Performs heavy physical labor, lift, carry, push and pull heavy objects, such as cement and fertilizer bags, (up to 50 lbs.) Walk, stand, stoop and crouch for long periods; climb ladders, dig and post holes.

Greets public, cooperates with other departments and provides information to public or directs them to the district office.

Other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Knowledge of and Skilled in: Effective oral and written communication skills; methods, tools, and equipment used in park and recreation maintenance to also include all facilities; turf grass care, irrigation systems, landscape maintenance, facility operation, maintenance and repair. Knowledge of hazards and safety precautions of the profession: occupational safety procedures, safe operation of maintenance equipment; safe operations of facilities; proper handling and application of pesticides and fertilizers.

Ability to: Follow and understand oral and written instructions and schedules; work harmoniously and cooperatively with fellow employees and the public; maintain neat and appropriate appearance; effectively communicate orally and in writing; work independently with minimal supervision; analyze situations and adopt effective courses of action; perform physically demanding work in varying outdoor weather conditions. Read and understand schematic diagrams and manuals; maintain technical, statistical and historical documents and databases, interpret technical information and exercise expertise in the field; operate tools and equipment necessary for performance safely in the field; diagnose and repair equipment problems; learn computer programs and customer information systems; make presentations, oral reports, submit written reports; work early morning hours; work late afternoon/evening hours, weekends, and holidays as required.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

Must be at least 18 years old. High school diploma or equivalent required. Two years of experience in facility maintenance, landscaping, turf maintenance, construction, groundskeeping or related experience preferred.

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CERTIFICATES AND LICENSE

Valid California Driver's License. Insurable under District policy. Pesticide Applicator Certification is desirable. CPR/AED First Aide Certificate. Must be fingerprinted and pass a background investigation.

COMPENSATION

Salary Range is \$41,600 - \$47,840 per year, DOE. Benefits include medical, dental, vision, life insurance and retirement program, paid vacation, sick leave, and holidays.

STATUS

Full-time; Non-Exempt
